Contribution Agreement - Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial

(For contributions of \$5,000 and over)

This Agreement is entered into as of the _____ day of _____, 20____, between

(Contributor) and Freedom Memorials, Inc. (FMI).

- 1. Contributions:** A tax deductible donation to Freedom Memorials, Inc. - EIN# 35-2277798. A contribution can be made via business or personal check drawn on a US bank in \$US or by wire transfer.
- 2. Estimated Memorial Cost:** The Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial is estimated to cost \$40 million, which includes a \$10 million endowment fund.
- 3. Use of Funds:** Contributions will be used to construct a memorial honoring the troops who lost, and will lose, their lives in the Iraq and Afghanistan wars. It will also honor the hostile-related wounded. A Memorial Hall will be constructed adjacent to the memorial that will feature a tribute to the safety personnel who lost their lives trying to save others after the World Trade Center attacks of September 11. The Hall will also recognize sponsors who helped make the memorial possible. The memorial will feature individual surgical stainless steel tributes to each fallen hero. Each tribute will include the warrior's photo and a dedication written by a loved one. An endowment fund will be established that will provide funding for perpetual cleaning, grounds upkeep, insurance, and maintenance. This is a Living Memorial, meaning tributes will be added yearly until these wars are declared over. - 4. Funding Shortfall:** This is not a likely scenario, but it must be mentioned in keeping with full disclosure. We first completed a survey which included hundreds of personal interviews and an online questionnaire. The responses were overwhelmingly positive. 91% of respondents said they would like to see this memorial constructed. When asked about donating to this project, 41% responded they would *Definitely* donate and 27% responded they would *Probably* donate. The National September 11 Memorial & Museum has raised \$300 million as of October 2007. The Pentagon and Flight 93 memorial projects are well on their way to reaching their funding requirements. We believe people across the USA, based on our research, will support this memorial to these fallen heroes as well. But if that ultimately proves not to be the case, and again, we do not believe there will be a shortfall, we will use the funding that's in place to do two things. One, we will make sure that each family of a fallen warrior receives a stainless tribute plaque, as described on our Web site and in our literature. Second, we will redesign a fitting memorial that can be produced with the funding on hand.
- 5. Communications:** Communications may be oral or written, may be given personally, by first class mail, by telephone, by facsimile machine, or by e-mail. In the case of facsimile notification or e-mail, the person to be contacted shall acknowledge personal receipt of the facsimile or e-mail notice by a return message or telephone call within twenty four hours of receipt of such transmission.

Each patron will also receive a framed black granite plaque** having a 3" gold, silver or bronze enameled Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial medallion with a personal Diamond Memory™ tribute.

Each patron will be honored in all publications, featured on the Website, and invited to all special events. All patrons and their personal comments will be archived on disk and available for viewing in Memorial Hall. Each patron will also receive an Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial die struck eagle lapel pin. Plaque size: 10" x 12".

Bronze Patron: \$25,000 - \$49,999

- **Benefactor: (\$5,000 - \$24,999)** Each Benefactor will receive a framed black granite plaque having a 3" bronze, enameled Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial medallion with a personal Diamond Memory™ tribute. Each benefactor's name, city, and state will be featured on a recognition plaque (14 pt. Times New Roman Bold) in Memorial Hall. Each benefactor will be honored in all publications, featured on the Website, and invited to all special events. All benefactors and their personal comments will be archived on disk and available for viewing in Memorial Hall. Each benefactor will also receive an Afghanistan & Iraq Freedom Reigns Memorial die struck eagle lapel pin. Plaque size: 9" x 12".

7. **Premium Delivery:** Each premium is individually crafted. Delivery times will vary based on the workload and scheduling. An estimated delivery date will be given each contributor. If there is any deviation in that date, the contributor will be immediately notified.
8. **Choice of Law:** The laws of the state of North Carolina shall govern the validity of this Agreement.
9. **Arbitration:** Any controversies arising out of the terms of this Agreement or its interpretation shall be settled in Raleigh, North Carolina in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and the judgment upon award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof.
10. **Headings:** Section headings are not to be considered a part of this Agreement and are not intended to be a full and accurate description of the contents hereof.
11. **Modification or Amendment:** No amendment, change, or modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing signed by the parties hereto.
12. **Entire Understanding:** This document and any exhibit attached constitute the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
13. **Unenforceability of Provisions:** If any provision of this Agreement, or any portion thereof, is held to be invalid and unenforceable, then the remainder of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.
14. **Contribution:** A contribution is henceforth made to Freedom Memorials, Inc. The total amount being \$US _____. The Contributor is duly recognized by Freedom Memorials, Inc. and will receive all the benefits pertaining to said Sponsorship Level aforementioned in this Agreement.
